Remarks

Born in England and educated at Oxford University, the art critic Charles Caffin immigrated to the United States in 1897. He soon began writing articles on

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photography in the *New York Evening Post* and later the *New York Sun*. His 1901 book *Photography as a Fine Art* was praised as one of the first serious works on the aesthetics of the medium by an art critic. A regular contributor to *Camera Work* throughout its entire run (1903–1917), Caffin wrote more articles for the periodical than anyone else.
