WASHINGTON, May 15: David E. Finley, Director of the National Gallery of Art, announces that a large and important exhibition of American painting is on its way to England to be shown during the coming summer at the Tate Gallery in London. The exhibition was organized by the National Gallery at the request of the Department of State and in compliance with the invitation received more than a year ago from the Trustees of the Tate Gallery for such an exhibition. The expenses of the exhibition, incurred outside the United States, are being borne by the Tate Gallery.

It is expected that the exhibition will open in London about the middle of June and will continue for six weeks. It will consist of 230 paintings by American artists of the eighteenth, nineteenth, and twentieth centuries.

The paintings were chosen by two committees appointed by the National Gallery of Art with authority to

make final selection of the works of art to go to London. Paintings by artist of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries were chosen by George H. Edgell, Director of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston: Fiske Kimball, Director of the Philadelphia Museum of Art: Francis Henry Taylor, Director of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York: John Walker, Chairman, Chief Curator of the National Gallery of Art, Washington, D. C.

Paintings by artists of the twentieth century were chosen by Alfred H. Barr, Jr., Director of Research at the Museum of Modern Art, New York: Mrs. Juliana Force, Director of the Whitney Museum of American Art, New York: William M. Milliken, Director of the Cleveland Museum of Art: Daniel Catton Rich, Director of the Art Institute, Chicago: Duncan Phillips, Chairman, Director of the Phillips Memorial Gallery, Washington, D. C.
