Pinley, Director, Mational Gallery of Art, speaking on behalf of the Conseittee of American Museums which brought the Ametrican Collection to this country for exhibit, announced that the pollection is now being leaded in Philadelphia absend the S. The collection was shown first at the National Gallery of Art in Washington and was subsequently shown at the Metropolitan Museum in New York, the M. H. deYoung Memorial Museum, San Francisco, the Chicago Art Institute, and suscess in St. Louis, Tolodo, Toronto, Boston, and Philadelphia. It was viewed by approximately three and a half million people.
