WASHINGTON, January 12, 1954: Forty of the most distinguished foreign art museum directors and representatives of museums from all parts of the world (list attached) will come to Washington for a visit of three days on January 19, 20, and 21.

They are now in New York attending the International Congress on Art History and Museology which is being held in honor of the reopening of the galleries of painting at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and also in honor of the Bicentennial of Columbia University.

On January 19, the delegates will lunch at the National Gallery of Art, when the Cultural Attachés of the various Embassies and Legations, and also representatives of Washington museums and cultural institutions are invited to meet them. That afternoon they will visit the Freer Gallery of Art. Later, they will be guests of Mrs. Truxtun Beale at tea at Decatur House on Lafayette Square. In the evening, they will share honors with the Colombian Ambassador and Señora Zuleta-Angel as guests of the Director of the National Gallery and Mrs. David Finley, at dinner at the Sulgrave Club, going afterwards to the National Gallery for the opening of the Exhibition of Pre-Columbian Gold Objects from Bogotá.

On January 20, the foreign delegates will visit the various museums and cultural institutions of Washington; they will lunch at Dumbarton Oaks, and be guests at tea of Mrs. Arthur Woods in Georgetown. In the evening, a number of dinners are being given by the various Embassies and also by Mr. and Mrs. Robert Woods Bliss, in honor of the delegates.

On January 21, the delegates will lunch at the Textile Museum and will visit Mount Vernon, where they will be guests. at tea of the Regent of the Mount Vernon Ladies' Association. They will leave on the morning of January 22 for Wilmington and New York.
