GIFT OF ART LIBRARY OF THE LATE JULIUS MEIER-GRAEFE
TO THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART

Washington, D. C., July 17: It was announced at the National Gallery of Art today that the library of the late Julius Meier-Graefe, noted art critic and historian, has been given to the Gallery by Mr. E. J. Rousuck of New York City. The books, numbering over 300 volumes, are especially important to the Gallery's Library because of the annotations made in them by Dr. Meier-Graefe. The collection is also rich in illustrated folios of the work of modern artists.
