NATIONAL GALLERY CONCERTS RESUME

WASHINGTON, September 11, 1958. John Walker, Director of the National Gallery of Art, announced today that the Gallery's Seventeenth Season of Sunday evening concerts will begin on September 21, 1958, and continue through June 21, 1959. The A. W. Mellon Concerts are under the general direction of Richard Bales, who also conducts the programs by the National Gallery Orchestra.

The 1958-1959 season will mark Mr. Bales' sixteenth year in charge of music at the National Gallery of Art.

All concerts will be given in the East Garden Court of the National Gallery on Sunday evenings at 8:00 P. M.
